The 2009 Colorado High School Bridge Building Contest will be held the last day of National Engineers Week on Saturday, February 21, 2009 at the US Bureau of Reclamation Laboratories in the Denver Federal Center. The Bridge Building Contest is open to all high school students across Colorado. The competition asks students to design and construct model bridges using established specifications for the contest. The bridges are ranked based on the efficiency of their badges.

Every competitor receives an event poster, photo of bridge and participant, and a personalized certificate commemorating the event. The top five students in each region are presented with plaques and prizes. Approximately 150 students, parents, and local engineers attend the Colorado contest. The top winner from each region will receive a scholarship to attend a Colorado University of their choice. Also, the top 2 winners from each region will advance to the International Competition.
