
"Magical Mathematics"

"Mathematics plays a special role as the language of much of science and engineering, and also as a discipline unto itself, in some sense the science of patterns. In this talk we'll describe some beautiful, and even magical, mathematics (including some pure mathematics, some as it relates to other areas, and some trickery)."
