



FIRST® Tech Challenge is a robotics competition designed for students in grades 7-12 to compete head-to-head, using a sports model. Teams are responsible for designing, building, and programming their robots to compete in an alliance format with and against other teams. Teams, including students, coaches and mentors, are required to develop strategy and build robots based on sound engineering principles. Awards are given for the competition as well as for community outreach, design, and other real-world accomplishments.

- Register as a volunteer with *FIRST* – <http://firstinspires.org>
- Choose “Sign Up” if you a new volunteer or “Login” if you already have an account
- Choose “Volunteer Registration” and then “Event Volunteering” and then choose FTC.
- Find the event you want to volunteer for and then choose the role(s) you are interested in.
- Make sure you complete the Youth Protection Screening process and electronically sign the Consent form.
- A volunteer coordinator will confirm your assignment close to the date of the event.
