

Climax Molybdenum's Henderson Mine is located in Clear Creek County on the east side of the Continental Divide, fifty miles west of Denver, Colorado. The Henderson Mill is located on the west side of the Continental Divide, fifteen miles from the mine in Grand County. The Mine and the Mill are connected by the world's longest conveyor of its kind; a fifteen-mile elevated belt that passes underneath the Continental Divide through an old train tunnel and then above ground to the Mill.

In operation since 1976, Henderson has produced more than 200 million tons of ore and over a billion pounds of molybdenum during the past 36 years.

NSPE-CO will be hosted by Henderson Mine management who will provide a tour of the underground operations of the mine. Touring the Mill is not included. This is an outstanding opportunity to see a full scale hard rock mining operation that has been a centerpiece of Colorado's mining industry.

The luxury coach will depart from West Denver (you'll get complete location details in a confirmation email) at 7:45am, Thursday February 23, 2012. Following the tour, lunch will be provided by Climax Molybdenum's Henderson Mine. We'll then depart for the return trip, arriving back in West Denver by 3pm.

**It is mandatory that participants travel on the coach with the group- no individual arrivals or departures are allowed.** If you are unable to attend and notify the state office and we are able to fill your seat with another person, your registration will be refunded. If you do not show for the trip or we are not able to fill your seat we will not be able to issue a refund.

The tour group size is limited to the first 50 registrants. Members who take the tour may bring one (1) guest with them. Payment is required when signing up.

Climax Molybdenum has an extensive and successful safety program.

Attendees must:

1. have reached their 14th birthday.
2. be fully capable of walking unassisted, at a normal pace, at high altitude, for an extended distance.
3. be able to understand and follow the safety rules and procedures, including the use of protective equipment that will be provided.
4. not be fearful of venturing below ground.
