Bud Moore - A Friend to Remember

We lost one of our active and long standing members with the recent passage of Harold "Bud" Moore. Bud was a retired Electrical Engineer who was a manager for what used to be Johnson Electric on Union Avenue, for some 57 years. Johnson Electric became one of the primary electrical service companies in Pueblo, specializing in electrical motor and controls repairs, but also getting into traditional electrical maintenance and installations, with up to 60 employees. Even after the business was sold, Bud continued to work with his son (Larry's Electric) off and on for another 10 years. He was active with his chosen trade, by serving 36 years on the Pueblo Regional Building Electrical Board, and serving as a trainer for electrical apprentices seeking to become licensed electricians. Bud picked up a hobby of ham radio operation in 1950 and took it to an enviable level of capability. He was active in serving as a local relay person with the Navy / Marine Mars Station to allow servicemen to communicate with their families through radio transmissions. Bud was active with the group even with his recent declining health, a peach of a man, and a source of local history and interesting experiences. We would truly be lucky to live such a long and fulfilled life. Bud was 94.

NSPE Colorado November Board Meeting

Business was as usual. Membership continues to decline in Colorado, requiring the annual budget to be adjusted downward to compensate for projected lost revenues from dues. This resulted in a discussion on how to improve conditions to reverse the trend. An interesting comment came from one of the attendees that made sense. It started with the phrase "If you build it, they will come". In other words, you need an attraction -- or a reason to keep coming. This person went on to say that in his experience, a campaign to attract new members may be successful, but if the program is not there, the new members will not stay. So, how do we build a program that will naturally attract membership? If there was a simple solution, I would think that we would already be doing it.

My sense is that it is a multiple requirement to make a successful program. Due diligence, good program presentations, advance notice, leadership, reasonable cost, convenient time, a good group to network and socialize with, and a sense of belonging all contribute to a successful program. In short, it takes work. In a volunteer organization, the load must be distributed and willingly accepted to become successful. This Chapter is the smallest in membership in the state, but seems to function better than most. We appear to be doing some things right, but could do better.

COPE ANNUAL DUES PAYABLE NOW!


